Commissioners and district membership committee members are vital to the success of the on-boarding of new Cub Scouts and their parents.

The on-boarding process begins at the night of the recruitment. New Cub Scouts and their family members need to feel welcomed into the pack. The primary purpose of the joining night is to enroll the new Cub Scouts into Scouting.



Cub Scouts packs should schedule a meeting the week after the Sign-up Night to conduct Youth Protection Training with all new parents and organize new dens as needed. The District SLiME Patrol will come and assist with the Youth Protection Training as well as bring all materials to make slime for all the new Cub Scouts.



SLiME Patrol members will receive a Slime Kit from the Council Office which includes all of the necessary supplies to make slime and additional materials to work on the Cub Scout Bobcat Badge requirements. A youth protection DVD, facilitators guide and training record sheet are included in the packet to provide the training to all new Cub Scout Parents and any volunteers that need to renew their Youth Protection training.
